ASPIRE: Academic Study Preparation through Intensive Readiness English is a program for non-native speaking students, to prepare them for degree programs at

SU or other American universities. The Salisbury University English Language Institute (ELI) is a four-level program, wherein students are placed based on scores from placement tests administered upon arrival. ELI students are required to maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher in order to advance to higher levels and graduate from the program. ASPIRE graduates are eligible to apply and matriculate into university degree programs.

SAYA: Study A Year in America is for students from SU overseas

partnering institutions to experience one year of study at Salisbury University. The program consists of English language instruction through the ELI and life experience as an American university student. In addition, SAYA students who place at

Level 3 or higher are eligible for the Bridge Program, to simultaneously take ELI courses and academic courses. Upon completion of the SAYA ogram, students are awarded an SU-ELI certificate of completion and credits from their home institution.

LEAP: Language Experience in America Program is for students from SU overseas partnering institutions to participate in a semester-long language, cultural and academic experience at Salisbury University. The program consists of English language classes in reading, writing, speaking, grammar and elective courses. After successfully completing the program, LEAP students are awarded an SU-ELI certificate of completion and credits

from their home institution.

### ISAP: Intensive Study Abroad

**Program** is a summer opportunity that provides a rich, four-week-long learning experience for students from SU partnering institutions. This program integrates language, culture and academics through formal classroom instruction and academic and social experiences in various settings. ISAP offers students opportunities to see and experience American life. Students also spend weekends engaged in cultural excursions, visiting east coast cities, such as Ocean City, MD; Washington, D.C.; New York City, NY; and Philadelphia, PA. Upon successful completion of ISAP, participants receive a certificate from SU-ELI and credits from their home institution.



# ELI PROGRAM TUITION AND ESTIMATED COSTS (2015-16)

#### UNDERGRADUATE

United States government regulations require Salisbury University to verify the availability of adequate funding for all individuals planning to enroll in the English Language Institute. This funding must cover tution and living expenses for the duration of studies. When it is determined that a student is academically cligible for admission When it is determined that a student is academically eligible for admission and financially capable of supporting his fer education, Salisbury University issues to the student an I-20 form or DS-2019 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student/Exchange Visitor Status). The student may use this form, along with other required documentation, to apply for a student visa at a United States embassy or consulate abroad.
